CKC Non-Member Participation Fee:

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee:

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

\*\*\*Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, http://www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and then Forms On-line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Working Certificate Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Running order will be pre-selected by a draw. A running list will be available at the tests.

Each dog may only be entered in ONE of the WC, WCI, or WCX tests. A dog must have a CKC WC title before entering the WCI test, and have achieved a WCI title before running the WCX test.

Ducks and/or pheasants will be used for the Land stakes. Ducks will be used for the water stakes.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a CKC rosette.

Qualifying Tollers are eligible for the Fair Dinkum award and the Shilo Trophy. See the NSDTR Club of Canada website at www.toller.ca for the Fair Dinkum and Shilo trophy rules and eligibility. Entries forms for the Shilo Trophy must accompany your entry form and can be downloaded from: http://www.toller.ca/2011NatSpec/perpetuals.htm

Bitches in season MAY NOT compete in the tests.

Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of a bitch being in season, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the tests to qualify for a refund.

All Throwers, Judges and Competitors should wear dark or camouflage clothing. Handlers shall not wear white or light clothing at any time, but handlers may wear handling jackets for the blinds in the WCX.

The Flat-coated Retriever Society of Canada, its members and the land owners will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, BUT will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

Electric collars (either dummy or live) prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds, at any time during the event.

There shall be no training of dogs on the test grounds, except for single training bumpers which are thrown by hand by the handler, within 24 hours of the commencement of the event or at anytime during the event.


#### ATTN Field Titled Toller Veterans!!!
